POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

1. All families must pay a \$500 deposit. 50% of total membership fees are due by November 1, 2011. Full membership fees are due by December 1. Athletes whom have not paid their dues in full by Dec. 1st will not be allowed to train.
2. Late Registration Fee of \$150 will apply for any payments received after the registration deadline.
3. All athletes wishing to compete must be current with the national governing bodies' registration protocol. Typically registration is available day of event, though early registration is encouraged and usually less expensive.
4. All athletes must provide the following by the first day of training:
 - a. Medical release form
 - b. Permission to treat Form
 - c. Release of Liability
 - d. Signed Code of Conduct
5. The Crested Butte Ski Club, in conjunction with CBMST, will work to create parent associations for each of the given sports. Parent associations will exist to create a volunteer base for their sports' home events. Parents are encouraged to get involved and make these programs work for our valley.
6. CBMST is a competitive based program. While competition is encouraged it is not required. However, during times of competition training support may not be available to those athletes not competing with the group.
7. In cases of small group competition, 2 or less, travel support may not be provided. Competition support at event will be arranged through CBMST partner.

Athlete Code of Conduct

The following are general rules for participating with the Crested Butte Mountain Sports Team. These rules are guidelines for your conduct as a CBMST athlete. As a CBMST athlete, you are expected to act in a mature and responsible manner as your actions are a reflection of your parents, coaches, and the program as a whole. Your behavior directly affects the team's reputation, standing in the community and ability to access better training opportunities and cooperation from the mountain. These rules and the rules found in the CBMST handbook must be adhered to. Any rule infraction may result in disciplinary action as set forth in the CBMST handbook.

ON-HILL POLICIES AND BEHAVIOR

1. Remember, we are ambassadors for the area, and we need to act as such at all times. Please show respect for your coaches, teammates, public skiers, and employees of Crested Butte Mountain Resort.
2. Foul language on the hill or in the club room is unacceptable. Directing profanity towards your teammates or coaches directly or indirectly, on-hill or off, will be taken very seriously and will be dealt with accordingly.
3. All athletes will arrive at training with a good positive attitude. Athletes will be expected to be attentive and energetic or they will not be welcome to train.
4. Always carry your season pass.
5. Be courteous when presenting your ski pass at all resorts. The lift attendant is simply doing their job!
6. Obey the skier's responsibility code. The general public comes first at all resorts. Typically you will be the better skier or rider, be respectful to those learning the sports we all know and love.
7. No tucking on any slope unless we are training and are supervised by a coach.
8. No lift line cutting.
9. If public skiers run one of our courses, do not yell at them; politely ask them to refrain from doing so and explain what the course is for. If you have a problem, find a coach.
10. Athletes should present themselves with an appropriate Athletic demeanor.
11. In case of emergency, call the ski patrol or go to a lift attendant for assistance.

TRAINING ATTIRE:

1. Helmets must be worn at all times.
2. Training attire is different for every sport. Please check with your Head Coach during the first weeks of training to find out what is expected of the athletes.

EQUIPMENT

Equipment needs vary by sport and level. Please check with your head coach in the fall to find out what will be expected for the athletes individual needs.

Your equipment is your responsibility. Take an active interest in learning proper tuning techniques. By the time you are a 13, you should be able to maintain your skis/board without the help of your coaches or parents.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

School work is just as important as competing in sports.

1. Each athlete must maintain a 2.0 gpa to continue to train and compete with CBMST. If acceptable grades are not maintained at all times, the privilege of training and racing may be taken away.

2. It is the athlete's responsibility to inform their teachers **in advance** of absence from class for races or special training.
3. It is the athlete's responsibility to make up missed assignments and/or find a tutor if needed.

TEAM ROOM AND OFFICE

1. Please be respectful off all locker room space.
2. Every day one team will be responsible for locker room clean up.
3. Wrestling and roughhousing will not be tolerated in the team room.
4. The team and coaches' offices are off-limits unless invited.
5. Tuning benches are there for everyone's use. Please clean up after yourself.
6. Hard goods can be stored in locker room overnight. Soft goods and boots must return home with the athletes daily.
7. CBMST is not responsible for lost tuning supplies or equipment.
8. Borrowing other teammates' equipment without permission will be treated as stealing.
9. Only the coaching staff may use video equipment, cameras, drills, etc.
10. If eating lunch in the building, athletes are responsible for cleaning up after themselves.
11. Drugs of any kind are illegal and their use is prohibited by CBMST members. Alcohol and tobacco are illegal for those under the age of 21, and their use is prohibited. CBMST will enforce these laws and will contact the police if we find anyone breaking these laws.
12. No pets are allowed in the building, team room, or on the hill.

PENALTIES FOR RULE INFRACTIONS

CBMST will enforce the above code of conduct. Any disrespect or disregard for these rules will be met with serious consequences.

1. Infraction 1: Dismissal from practice for the day.
2. Infraction 2: Suspension from practice and races for the week.
3. Infraction 3: Release from the team with NO MONETARY COMPENSATION.

WARNING, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY & INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING. THIS IS A RELEASE OF LIABILITY & WAIVER OF LEGAL RIGHTS.

1. Definitions. The person who is participating in the Mountain Sports Team shall be referred to hereinafter as "Participant". The "Undersigned" means only the Participant when the Participant is age 18 or older OR it means both the Participant and the Participant's parent or legal guardian when the Participant is under the age of 18. "Released Parties" mean Crested Butte, LLC, Triple Peaks, LLC, Resort Asset Management, or any of their respective successors in interest, affiliated organizations and companies, insurance carriers, agents, employees, representatives, assignees, officers, directors, members, and shareholders; and the U.S. Forrest Service. The "Activity" means taking part in the Mountain Sports Team, competitions, skiing, snowboarding, training, and using the ski area facilities, including the lifts, for any purpose.

2. Risks of Activity. The Undersigned agree and understand that taking part in the Activity can be HAZARDOUS AND INVOLVES THE RISK OF PHYSICAL INJURY AND/OR DEATH. The Undersigned acknowledge that the Activity is inherently dangerous and fully realize the dangers of participating in the Activity. The risks and dangers of the activity include, but are not limited to: falling; slick or uneven surfaces; surface and subsurface snow conditions; bumps; moguls; ice; variations in terrain; rugged mountainous terrain; downed timber; stumps; forest growth; rocks; debris; marked and unmarked obstacles; man-made objects; lift towers; terrain park features and elements; visibility; collisions; encounters with snowmobiles and/or other motor vehicles; lift loading, unloading, and riding; adverse weather; avalanches; limited access to and/or delay of medical attention; fatigue; exhaustion; dehydration; hypothermia; high elevation; altitude sickness; frostbite; mental distress from exposure to any of the above; and negligence of others. THE UNDERSIGNED ACKNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTAND THAT THE DESCRIPTION OF THE RISKS LISTED ABOVE IS NOT COMPLETE AND THAT PARTICIPATING IN THE ACTIVITY MAY BE DANGEROUS AND MAY INCLUDE OTHER RISKS.

3. Duties of Participant. The Participant assumes the responsibility of maintaining control at all times while engaging in the Activity. Participant is responsible for reading, understanding and complying with all signage, including instructions on use of lifts. Participant must have the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride and unload the lifts. Participant acknowledges that he/she has the physical dexterity and knowledge to safely load, ride, and unload the lifts. Participant assumes the risks of riding the lifts and engaging in activities accessible from the lifts. Further, the Undersigned understand that a minor Participant may use the ski lifts without an adult present. Participant acknowledges that snowmobiles, snowmaking, snow-grooming equipment and/or other motor vehicles and equipment may be encountered at any time. Participant understands that entering or skiing in a "CLOSED" area is illegal.

4. Release, Indemnification, and Assumption of Risk. In consideration of the Participant being permitted to participate in the activity, the Undersigned agree as follows:

(a) **Release.** THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY IRREVOCABLY AND UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASE, FOREVER DISCHARGE, AND AGREE NOT TO SUE OR BRING ANY OTHER LEGAL ACTION AGAINST THE RELEASED PARTIES with respect to any and all claims and causes of action of any nature whether currently known or unknown, which the Undersigned, or any of them, have or which could be asserted on behalf of the Undersigned in connection with the Participant's participation in the Activity, including, but not limited to claims of negligence, breach of warranty, and/or breach of contract.

(b) **Indemnification.** The Undersigned hereby agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Released Parties from and against any and all liability, cost, expense or damage of any kind or nature whatsoever and from any suits, claims or demands, including legal fees and expenses whether or not in litigation, arising out of, or related to, Participant's participation in the Activity. Such obligation on the part of the Undersigned shall survive the period of the Participant's participation in the Activity.
