Borealis Fat Bike World Championships

The third annual Borealis Fat Bike World Championships will be held on January 25-28. Featuring a fat bike vendor showcase, demos, races and lift-served fat biking, it is a weekend that bike enthusiasts will not want to miss!

Thursday and Friday's events will be held in the Town of Mt. Crested Butte at the North Village/Snodgrass meadow. Located just over one mile past Crested Butte Mountain Resort, this venue is groomed for this very occasion. Join in on the fun by spectating or participating in the free Demo Day on Friday (no registration necessary). Saturday's race will be held in the town of Crested Butte near the public school and Nordic Center trails at Town Ranch. Sunday's event will feature lift-served fat biking on the Gold Link Lift at CBMR. Participants may purchase discounted lift tickets valid for the Gold Link Lift only with their Fat Bike Worlds registration. Please park at the Snodgrass Trailhead and ride your bike down Prospect Road to access the lift.

Free Local Transportation

Ride the Mountain Express Shuttle for FREE!

The colorful, locally hand-painted Town Shuttle buses run every 15 minutes during the winter season. The first bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall in downtown Crested Butte at 7:10 am and leaves from Mountaineer Square in Mt. Crested Butte at 7:30 am. The last bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall at 11:40 pm and leaves the mountain from Mountaineer Square at midnight.

Condo Shuttles: Three routes serve most of the condominiums in Mt. Crested Butte with frequencies of 15 and 30 minutes. Each of these routes connects with the Town Shuttle at the Transit Center at Mountaineer Square. Between 10 - 11:30 pm, pick-up service is available by calling (970) 275-3469, if there is no answer, leave a message to get a return call from the bus driver.
