Free Local Transportation

Ride the Mountain Express Shuttle for FREE!

The colorful, locally hand-painted Town Shuttle buses run every 15 minutes during the winter season. The first bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall in downtown Crested Butte at 7:10 am and leaves from Mountaineer Square in Mt. Crested Butte at 7:30 am. The last bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall at 11:40 pm and leaves the mountain from Mountaineer Square at midnight.

Condo Shuttles: Three routes serve most of the condominiums in Mt. Crested Butte with frequencies of 15 and 30 minutes. Each of these routes connects with the Town Shuttle at the Transit Center at Mountaineer Square. Between 10 - 11:30 pm, pick-up service is available by calling (970) 275-3469, if there is no answer, leave a message to get a return call from the bus driver.
