## The Alley Loop

Crested Butte is not your typical mountain town. History, character and color differentiate us to be *Colorado's Last Great Ski Town* and our events follow the same moniker.

The 32<sup>nd</sup> annual Alley Loop Nordic Marathon is one of the Crested Butte Nordic Center's largest events of the year and brings in some of the top cross country skiers in the country on Saturday, February 3. The Alley Loop starts, finishes and passes through the heart of downtown Crested Butte, winding around on snow covered streets, through narrow alleys and over single-file bridges. Much of the local community comes out in support of the racers, many of whom are dressed in their most colorful costumes. After passing through downtown, the course continues on perfectly groomed and undulating trails out the Slate River drainage.

Whether you are competing or spectating, the Alley Loop delivers. There are several different courses and distances that allow for all ages and ability levels to participate: 1.5k, 3k, 5k, 10k, 21k and 42k distances.

The Crested Butte Nordic Center says it best, "if you like normal, you may want to look for another race. If you are up for anything, this is right up your alley!"

## Free Local Transportation

**Ride the Mountain Express Shuttle for FREE!**

The colorful, locally hand-painted Town Shuttle buses run every 15 minutes during the winter season. The first bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall in downtown Crested Butte at 7:10 am and leaves from Mountaineer Square in Mt. Crested Butte at 7:30 am. The last bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall at 11:40 pm and leaves the mountain from Mountaineer Square at midnight.

**Condo Shuttles:** Three routes serve most of the condominiums in Mt. Crested Butte with frequencies of 15 and 30 minutes. Each of these routes connects with the Town Shuttle at the Transit Center at Mountaineer Square. Between 10 - 11:30 pm, pick-up service is available by calling (970) 275-3469, if there is no answer, leave a message to get a return call from the bus driver.
