Crested Butte Bike Week

The oldest mountain bike festival in the world! From June 20 through 24, this is where a rider can experience the birthplace of mountain biking while riding miles and miles of singletrack. This family friendly celebration is now four days and attracts riders of all levels! There are clinics, a junior component, guided trail rides, yoga for bikers, films, music, races of all sorts and so much more! Dads Ride Free on Father's Day!

Join Crested Butte Mountain Resort in celebrating Father's Day on June 17. Families are encouraged to head up to the mountain for a day of exploring on the chairlifts, Evolution Bike Park and throughout the Adventure Park. On Sunday, June 17, only, Dads can receive a free Scenic Lift Ticket or Adventure Ticket with the purchase of a Child (7-17) ticket of the same type.

The Evolution Bike Park

The Evolution Bike Park is one of the top attractions in the valley. With over 30 miles of trails and a variety of terrain for all ability levels, there is gravity riding for everyone. The downhill enthusiast can ride incredible expert terrain with rock gardens, jumps, berms and more, while a novice can learn the basics of mountain biking and riding single track in the Skills Zone and on the beginner trails. High Mountain 3D Archery Competition

On June 24, Crested Butte Mountain Resort and West Elk Archers will host the fifth annual 3D competition giving archers the chance to access the beautiful Gunnison National Forest via the Red Lady Express Chairlift.

Participants will take the lift up to the start of the course at 10,300' with amazing views of the Elk Mountain Range to the North. A Sight-in Range will be set near the top of the lift for archers to warm up before starting the course. From there, archers will follow the course through open country and dark timber along 30 targets during this one-day competition.

Registration is \$30 for adults, \$15 for children (ages 7-17) and ages 6 and under can participate for free! All prices include your lift ride up to the course. For friends and family members wishing to spectate, they can receive a discounted single ride ticket for \$10 each for access to the course. Participants must register the day of the event from 8:30-10:30 am at Coal Breaker Coffee in the Treasury Building.

The Town Shuttle runs every 20 minutes during the summer schedule with the first bus up the mountain from Old Town Hall in downtown Crested Butte at 7:35 am, and down from Mountaineer Square in Mt. Crested Butte at 8 am. The last bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall at 11:35 pm and leaves the mountain from Mountaineer Square at midnight.
