Summer 2018 Opening Day!

Join Crested Butte Mountain Resort and the Evolution Bike Park for our Summer 2018 Opening Day on June 9! We can't wait to see you on the mountain! All 2018 CBMR summer season passes are valid, and the Red Lady and Silver Queen Express Lifts each start spinning at 9:30 am!

NOTE: Adventure tickets or summer season passes will be required for access to the lifts.

CB3P: Pole, Pedal, Paddle

The Crested Butte Pole, Pedal, Paddle takes place on April 29 and is a multi-sport endurance race that spans the length of the Gunnison Valley, starting at Crested Butte Mountain Resort and finishing at the Gunnison Whitewater Park. Featuring three distinct "legs" - an uphill/downhill ski, biking and kayaking - the CB3P takes participants and spectators on an exciting tour that follows the valley's spring runoff path.

Competitors can complete the race as individuals in the 'Race' or 'Fun' categories, or tackle the course as a team relay. More details can be found at skicb.com/events.

Environmental Stewardship

- Also, remember to recycle all paper products including coffee cups, magazines, newspapers and cardboard.

Ride the Mountain Express Shuttle for FREE!

The colorful, locally hand-painted Town Shuttle buses run every 40 minutes during the spring season. The first bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall in downtown Crested Butte at 7:35 am and leaves from Mountaineer Square in Mt. Crested Butte at 8 am. The last bus up the mountain departs from Old Town Hall at 10:55 pm and leaves the mountain from Mountaineer Square at 11:20 pm.
